Taras Shtonda is not only a principal soloist at the National Opera of Kiev and a "Merited Artist of Ukraine", but also a frequent guest at major opera houses and festivals around the world.

Shtonda's broad repertoire includes Filippo II (Don Carlo), Zaccaria (Nabucco) Ramphis and II Re (Aida), Don Basilio (II Barbiere di Siviglia), Méphistophélès (Faust), II Commendatore (Don Giovanni), Kotchubei (Mazepa), King Rene (Iolanta) and Prince Galitsky (Prince Igor) among many others.



Already in 2002 Taras Shtonda debuted at the Bolshoi

Theatre in Moscow as **Dossifey** and has sung leading roles there ever since, the latest being **Boris Godunov** and **Boris Izmaylov** (*Katerina Izmaylova*) in 2017. Shtonda has also sung **Dossifey** (*Khovanshchina*) in Warsaw (2002), **Raimondo** in *Lucia di Lammermoor* at the Mariinsky Theatre (2003) and **Pimen** in *Boris Godunov* at the Royal Opera House in London (2006). More recently, he was invited to sing **Oroveso** (*Norma*) at the Toulon Opera, **Faust** (*The Fiery Angel*) at Opera de Lyon and **Wotan** in Wagner's *Die Walküre* at the Mariinsky Theatre under Maestro Valery Gergiev. In the summer of 2015, Shtonda sang a highly acclaimed **Pimen** in *Boris Godunov* at the Savonlinna Opera Festival alongside Matti Salminen.

Some other highlights of his career include **Boris Godunov** at the Bolshoi theatre, **Prince Gremin** (*Eugen Onegin*) at the Oslo Opera House as well as at the Glyndebourne Festival, **Mamyrov** in Tchaikovsky's *Enchantress* at Vlaamse Opera Antwerp, **Grande Inquisitore** (*Don Carlo*) at the Bayerische Staatsoper in Munich, as well as **Four Villains** (*Les contes d'Hoffmann*), **Count Walther** (*Luisa Miller*), **Gurnemanz** (*Parsifal*) and **Nilakantha** in Delibes' Lakmé at Malmö Opera.

In 2017, Taras Shtonda made his debut as **Hagen** (*Götterdämmerung*) at Theater Kiel, and his most recent and future engagements include **Grande Inquisitore** (Don Carlos) at Covent Garden, **Hunding** (Die Walküre) at Frankfurt Opera, **Hagen** at the Oviedo Opera and **Fafner** (Rheingold/ Siegfried) at the Grand Théatre de Genève.
